

ORDINANCE NO. 26

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO STEVEN PARR, HIS ASSOCIATES AND ASSIGNS, THE RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A SYSTEM OF PIPES AND WORKS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION AND SALE OF ILLUMINATING AND FUEL GAS IN THE STREETS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC PLACES OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS AND TO CARRY ON THE BUSINESS OF SELLING SUCH GAS BY MEANS OF SUCH WORKS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: That the said Steven Parr, his associates and assigns, are hereby granted the right and privilege to construct and maintain within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, such pipes and works as may be convenient and necessary for the manufacture, production, generation and supply to said town and its inhabitants of illuminating and fuel gas, and to charge the consumer thereof reasonable rates therefor.

Section 2: That for the purpose aforesaid, the said Steven Parr, his associates and assigns, are hereby granted the right and privilege of laying down, relaying, connecting, disconnecting, repairing and maintaining all such mains and other pipes, along, through and under the avenues, streets, alleys, highways and public places of the said town of Granite Falls as may be necessary, proper or convenient for supplying such gas to consumers thereof and to make connections between such mains and pipes and the dwellings or other building of the consumers.

Section 3: That this ordinance and the rights granted thereby shall continue in force for the period of twenty-five (25) years from the date of its passage provided that unless the said Steven Parr shall, within thirty days from the date of the approval of this ordinance by the Mayor of said town, or by its becoming a law without his approval, file with the Town Clerk his written acceptance of this ordinance, then this ordinance shall become null and void, and that unless the said gas plant shall be in successful operation by January 1, 1907, this ordinance shall become null and void.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
