

ORDINANCE NO. 260

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY IN SECTION 18, TWP 30 N, R 7 EWM, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE GRANITE FALLS HIGH SCHOOL SITE.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON,  
DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: Whereas, on or about the 12th day of September, 1973, a notice of intention to annex the property described below to the Town of Granite Falls was filed, having been signed by the directors of Granite Falls School District #332, the owner of all said property; a meeting was duly set before the Town Council for the 10th day of October, 1973, at 8:00 p.m. to consider the said notice and that at said meeting the Town Council agreed to accept such annexation; and thereupon a petition for annexation pursuant to the provisions of RCW 35.13.130 was filed, and a hearing thereupon was set before the Town Council on the 14th day of November, 1973, at 8:00 p.m.; due notice of said hearing was published and posted in the manner provided by law; at the said hearing the Town Council unanimously voted to annex said territory; and an application having been filed with the Snohomish County Boundary Review Board with respect to such annexation in accordance with the provisions of RCW Chapter 36.93; and a hearing having been regularly held before the said Boundary Review Board at 7:30 p.m. on the 20th day of November, 1973, following which hearing said Boundary Review Board approved the proposal for such annexation in accordance with the provisions of RCW 36.93.150.

SECTION 2: The following described property be and the same hereby is annexed to the Town of Granite Falls, Snohomish County, Washington:

Beginning in the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter, thence East 37 rods (610.5 ft), thence at right angles North 33 rods more or less (544.5 ft.) to the Northerly line of the abandoned Hartford Eastern Railroad right-of-way, the true point of beginning. Thence South retracing the last above course to the South line of said subdivision, thence continue South from a point that is 610.5 feet East of the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter for 200 feet; thence North 89°32' West 27.42

feet; thence South 01°18'03" East 555.33 feet; thence South 01°45'56" West 142.25 feet; thence South 02°13' West 91.92 feet to the city limits of the Town of Granite Falls; thence along the city limits line North 89°35'01" West 69.25 feet; thence South 01°18'03" East 165 feet; thence North 89°35'01" West to a point 264 feet East of the West line of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 18; thence North along said city limits line to the North line of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 18; thence West 264 feet to the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 18; thence North along the West line of said subdivision to the North line of the abandoned right-of-way of the Hartford Eastern Railroad; thence Northeasterly along said right-of-way to the point of beginning.

SECTION 3: The effective date of such annexation shall be the date of this ordinance. The property annexed shall not assume any bonded indebtedness of the Town of Granite Falls. There being no comprehensive plan for the Town of Granite Falls, said property need not be in compliance therewith.

Passed at a regular meeting of the Town of Granite Falls, Town Council, held on the 28th day of November, 1973, and approved by the Mayor.
