

ORDINANCE NO. 264

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON THE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS FOR THE YEAR 1975 IN THE TOTAL SUM OF \$17,988.00 REGULAR LEVY AND \$2300.00 SPECIAL LEVY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied upon the real and personal property within the Town of Granite Falls with respect to the general levy for the year 1975, a tax of \$17,988.00 (approximately 3.37 1/2 per \$1,000.00 assessed value based on 100% true and fair value).

SECTION 2. There is hereby levied upon the real and personal property within the Town of Granite Falls for the year 1975 pursuant to the Special Levy adopted by the electors at a Special Election held on the 17th day of September, 1974, the sum of \$2,300.00, (approximately \$0.55 per \$1,000.00 assessed value based on 100% true and fair value).

SECTION 3. The proceeds of the foregoing regular and Special Levies are to be placed: \$12,458.00 in the Current Expense Fund, \$5,530.00 in the Street Fund and \$2,300.00 in the Library Fund.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting; according to law.
