

ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION SIX (6) OF ORDINANCE NO. 25 OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO STEVEN PARR, HIS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN WATERWORKS, MAINS AND PIPES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, AND TO SUPPLY THE SAID TOWN AND ITS INHABITANTS WITH PURE AND FRESH WATER."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: That Section six (6) of Ordinance No. 25 of the Town of Granite Falls entitled "An ordinance granting to Steven Parr, his successors and assigns the right, privilege and authority to construct and maintain waterworks, mains and pipes within the limits of the Town of Granite Falls, and to supply the inhabitants thereof with pure and fresh water" be amended to read as follows: Within thirty days after the passage and approval of this ordinance the said Grantee, his successors and assigns, may file in the office of the town clerk of the town of Granite Falls, Washington, his or their acceptance hereof, and in case such acceptance is not filed within said period of thirty days, then this ordinance shall be null and void, and further that if work on said waterworks plant be not commenced before April 1, 1905 and be in successful operation in said town of Granite Falls, Washington, before January 1, 1906 then this ordinance shall be null and void.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
