

ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE AND COLLECT FROM MALE INHABITANTS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 21 AND 50 YEARS AN ANNUAL STREET POLL TAX AND PRESCRIBING THE PENALTY FOR NONPAYMENT OF THE SAME, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: Every male inhabitant over 21 years of age and under 50 years shall be assessed and annually pay a street poll tax of \$2.00 per annum.

Section 2: The Town Marshal shall on or within one year after the 15th day of March of each year demand of each person liable to the payment of such poll tax, the amount thereof, and if such person shall refuse to pay said poll tax on demand of said officer or if such person shall neglect or fail to pay such poll tax on demand of the proper officer or if such person shall neglect and fail to pay such poll tax after such demand for a period of ten (10) days he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction therefor shall pay a sum not exceeding \$5.00 or be imprisoned not exceeding five (5) days or by both said fine and imprisonment.

Section 3: It shall be the duty of the marshal when collecting said street poll tax to furnish the person paying the same with a receipt therefor and that said receipt shall be evidence of having paid the same and all moneys received as poll taxes shall be paid promptly to the town treasurer taking his receipt therefor.

Section 4: That ordinance No. 8 and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
