

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL CIRCUSES, SHOWS, PEDDLERS AND AGENTS PERFORMING, OPERATING OR DOING BUSINESS IN THE TOWN OF GRANTIE FALLS TO BE LICENSED; FIXING THE AMOUNT OF THEIR LICENSE; DECLARING THE VIOLATION OF ANY OF ITS PROVISIONS A MISDEMANOR AND FIXING THE PENALTY THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the town of Granite Falls.

Section 1: That before any person or persons, company or corporation shall engage in any of the following vocations within the corporate limits of the town of Granite Falls they shall take out a license therefor and the fee for said license shall be the amount set opposite each and every of the following vocations: For a circus one day \$10. For a circus for the second day and each subsequent day \$7. For a side show to a circus charging a separate admission fee and for merry-go-rounds one day \$3. For a side show to a circus charging a separate admission fee and for merry-go-rounds for the second and each subsequent day \$2. For a theatrical or other entertainment to which an admission fee is charged, one day \$3.00. For a theatrical or other entertainment to which an admission fee is charged, for the second and each subsequent day \$1.50. For a foot or pack peddler not marketing his own or his neighbors farm products, each day \$1. For every person who sells goods, patent medicines or other drugs upon the street and conducts a game of chance in connection therewith, for each day \$3. For every peddler who peddles from a wagon, for each day \$2.50.

Section 2: Any person or persons, company or corporation desiring to engage in any of the occupations specified in Section 1 of this ordinance, within the corporate limits of the town of Granite Falls, shall, before engaging in the same, pay to the town treasurer the amount required for such license and upon receiving a receipt for said treasurer present the receipt to the town clerk who shall file the same and issue a license to such person, persons, company or corporation presenting the same, authorizing them to engage in the business specified and for the time mentioned in said receipt and shall charge the amount of said license fee to the treasurer.

Section 3: Any person, persons, company or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$5 and not more than \$100 with costs of the prosecution which costs shall be part of the fine and be imprisoned in the town jail till such fine be paid.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
