

ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND PREVENTING OBSTRUCTIONS TO STREETS, AVENUES, ALLEYS AND SIDEWALKS AND PRESCRIBING THE PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

Section 1: No person shall erect or maintain any building in such position that any part thereof shall extend upon any street, avenue or alley within the town of Granite Falls.

Section 2: No person shall put up or maintain or allow on any building owned by him or under his control any pipe or conductor from the eaves of any building, in such manner as to permit or cause thereby any flow of water from said spout, pipe or conductor across or upon any public sidewalk.

Section 3: No person shall throw or deposit upon any public street or alley, or upon any private premises or anywhere except in such places as may be designated by the town marshal, any glass, metal or broken ware, dirt, rubbish, garbage or filth, and no person shall carry upon any sidewalk, exposed so as to be offensive to pedestrians any rubbish, garbage or filth.

Section 4: No person shall disturb or remove any sidewalk, or any part or plank thereof or shall disturb, remove or tear up any planking upon any of the streets of said town, without first obtaining leave of the town marshal.

Section 5: No person shall lead or drive intentionally any animal or animals upon any of the sidewalks of the city.

Section 6: Any person by whom or under whose immediate authority, as principal or as contractor or employee shall disturb any portion of a public street whereby it may be made dangerous, shall erect, and so long as the danger shall continue, maintain around the portion of the street or highway so made dangerous a good and sufficient barrier and shall protect the same by red lights at night.

Section 7: No person shall drag any logs or timber upon any of the improved streets of the Town.

Section 8: No person shall erect or maintain any fence or other obstruction upon any street, avenue or alley within the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 9: It shall be unlawful for persons to gather in crowds or groups, or for any person to stand singly on any public street or sidewalk in the Town in such manner as to obstruct free passage thereon, or to annoy other persons passing along the same and the Town marshal or any of his deputies are hereby authorized to disperse any crowd or group, or to cause the removal of any person or persons, in case of the refusal on the part of such person or persons to obey any reasonable direction given by such officer for the purpose of clearing away or preventing annoyance to passers by on any public street or sidewalk.

Section 10: The violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and shall subject the offender upon conviction thereof to a fine not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars or to imprisonment not exceeding thirty days or to both such fine and imprisonment.
