

ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF ORDINANCE NO. 14 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE WIDTH AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR OF SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, REGULATING THE MANNER OF CONSTRUCTION, AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE COSTS OF THE SAME IF OWNERS OF ABUTTING PROPERTY SHALL FAIL TO CONSTRUCT OR REPAIR THE SAME ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE" AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

Section 1: That Section One (1) of Ordinance No. 14 be amended to read as follows:

Section 1: That all sidewalks hereafter build on Granite Avenue, from the South side of the railway right-of-way to the North side of Pioneer Street shall be a uniform width of ten (10) feet and that the sidewalks on all other streets shall be a uniform width of six (6) feet.

Section 2: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
