ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE AMOUNT OF BONDS REQUIRED OF THE TOWN OFFICIALS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, as follows:

Section 1: That the Town Clerk of said Town be required to furnish and his bond is hereby fixed at the sum of \$1,000.00.

Section 2: That the Town Treasurer of said town be required to furnish and his bond is hereby fixed at the sum of \$4,000.00.

Section 3: That the town Marshal be required to furnish and his bond is hereby fixed at the sum of \$1,000.00.

Section 4: That the Judge of the municipal court of said town be required to furnish and his bond is hereby fixed at the sum of \$250.00.

Section 5: That the town Council may in its discretion require the Town Clerk, Treasurer and Marshal to furnish security Company Bonds in which event said bonds shall be procured and paid for by the Town of Granite Falls.
