

ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SEC. NINE (9) OF ORDINANCE NO. TWLEVE (12), ENTITLED; "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING, TAXING, REGULATING AND RESTRAINING OF THE SALE OF SPIRITOUS, VINOUS, FERMENTED, MALT AND OTHER INTOXICATING LIQUORS, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, FIXING THE AMOUNT OF THE LICENSE FEE AND THE METHOD OF PROCURING A LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF SUCH LIQUORS, DECLARING THE VIOLATION OF ITS PROVISIONS A MISDEMEANOR AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE"; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

That Sec. Nine (9) of Ordinance No. Twelve (12) of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, be amended to read as follows:

Section 9: That rates for licenses under this ordinance shall be as follows: Retail liquor license Five hundred (\$500.00) dollars per year.

Wholesale liquor license one hundred (\$100.00) dollars per year.

Wholesale and retail liquor licenses five hundred fifty (\$550.00) dollars per year.

A license for the sale or giving away of intoxicating liquors in quantities of less than one gallon shall be known as a retail license; and a license for the sale or giving away of intoxicating liquors in quantities of more than one gallon shall be known as a wholesale license; and a license for the sale or giving away of intoxicating liquors in quantities less than one gallon, one gallon and more than one gallon shall be known as a wholesale and retail license.

That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
