

ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 10, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL"; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 19, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 10, ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL.'"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: The regular meetings of the Town Council shall be held on the first and third Tuesdays of each month at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., and said regular meetings may be adjourned from time to time during the month, as necessity may require by the majority vote of the members of the Council present at any such regular meeting.

Section 2: The Mayor shall have the power to call special meetings of the Town Council at any time he may deem necessary, and shall call such special meetings upon the written request of three members of the Council; and three members of said Council may call such special meeting in case of the absence of the Mayor from Town by giving twenty-four (24) hours written notice of such meeting to the other members of the Council.

Section 3: All meetings of the town Council shall be hereafter held in the one story frame building situated on the East side of Granite Avenue, between Pioneer and Union Streets, said building being adjacent to the Post Office building on the north and owned by A. C. Robes, and occupied by the Town of Granite Falls as a Town Hall.

Section 4: That Ordinance No. 10, entitled "An Ordinance fixing the time and place of meeting of the Town Council" be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 5: That Ordinance No. 19, entitled "An Ordinance amending Sec. 3 of Ordinance No. 10, entitled 'An Ordinance fixing the time and place of meeting of the Town Council'" be and the same is hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
