

ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 41, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION NINE (9) OF ORDINANCE NO. TWO (2) ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF A TOWN MARSHAL AND FOR FILLING VACANCIES IN SAID OFFICE DEFINING HIS DUTIES AND FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF SAID MARSHAL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS'" AND FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE SAID MARSHAL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 41, entitled "An Ordinance amending Section nine (9) of Ordinance No. Two (2) entitled 'An Ordinance providing for the appointment and confirmation of a town marshal and for filling vacancies in said office, defining the duties and fixing the compensation of the said marshal of the Town of Granite Falls'" be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2: The marshal shall receive for his services the sum of \$60.00 per month.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
