

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION TWO (2) OF ORDINANCE NO. FOURTEEN (14) ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE WIDTH AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR OF SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON; REGULATING THE MANNER OF CONSTRUCTION AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE COSTS OF THE SAME IF THE OWNERS OF ABUTTING PROPERTY SHALL FAIL TO CONSTRUCT OR REPAIR THE SAME ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE", AND REGULATING THE MATERIAL OF WHICH AND THE MANNER IN WHICH SIDEWALKS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: That Section Two (2) of Ordinance No. Fourteen (14) entitled "An Ordinance fixing the width and providing for the construction and repair of sidewalks within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington; regulating the manner of construction, and providing for the collection of the costs of the same if the owners of abutting property shall fail to construct or repair the same according to the provisions of this ordinance" be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2: That all sidewalks hereafter constructed within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, shall be made of sound sawed, merchantable fir plank six (6) inches in width, surfaced on one side and at least two inches thick, laid at right angles to and firmly spiked to the stringers, of which for all walks there shall be at least three (3) four by four (4x4) inch stringers laid upon solid foundation. All planks in sidewalks shall be laid with an open crack between each two planks of from one-half (1/2) to three quarters (3/4) of an inch in width; shall be laid with the surfaced side up, and shall not project more than three inches beyond the outside stringers. Except that they shall extend to and be securely spiked to the gutter plank at least once every ten (10) feet.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and publication according to law.
