

ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING CERTAIN OFFENSES WHICH SHALL BE MISDEMEANORS WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE COMMISSION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That any person who shall, within the limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, maliciously mischievously, or without reasonable cause make or give any false alarm of fire, or ring or sound any triangle, bell or other fire alarm apparatus belonging to said Town of Granite Falls, Washington, or to the fire department thereof, or meddle with, fire alarm apparatus belonging to the said Town of Granite Falls, Washington, or to the fire department thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined One hundred (\$100) dollars or imprisoned in the Town jail for thirty (30) days.
