

ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF MOSS FROM THE ROOFS OF BUILDINGS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, PROVIDING A METHOD OF COLLECTING THE COST OF SUCH REMOVAL AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: Any person or persons owning any building within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington on the roof of which moss shall be allowed to accumulate and who shall refuse or neglect to remove said moss within ten (10) days after he or they have received notice from the Town Marshal to remove the same, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five (\$25) dollars.

Section 2: If the owner or owners of any building within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, shall refuse or neglect for ten (10) days after receiving the notice provided for in Section 1 of this ordinance to remove the moss from the roof of the building owned by him or them, the Town Marshal may enter on said premises and cause the said roof to be cleaned of moss and the cost thereof shall be collected in an action brought in the name of the Town of Granite Falls as plaintiff against the owner or owners of said buildings.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect on and after its passage and publication as required by law.
