

ORDINANCE NO. 53

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION THREE (3) OF ORDINANCE NO. 45, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 10 ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL' AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 19 ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 10 ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL'".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

That Section three (3) of Ordinance No. 45 entitled "An ordinance fixing the time and place of meeting of the Town Council and repealing ordinance No. 10 entitled 'an Ordinance fixing the time and place of meeting of the town Council' and repealing Ordinance NO. 19 entitled 'An Ordinance amending Section 3 of Ordinance No. 10 entitled An ordinance fixing the time and place of meeting of the Town Council'" be amended to read as follows:

Section 3: All meetings of the Town Council shall hereafter be held in the two story frame building situate on the West side of Granite Avenue between Union and Pioneer Streets and known as the G.A.R. Hall.
