

ORDINANCE NO. 54

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE DUTIES, FIXING THE HOURS OF SERVICE AND COMPENSATION, AND FIXING THE AMOUNT OF BOND OF THE DEPUTY MARSHAL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: The duties of the deputy marshal of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington shall be the same during the hours of service hereinafter fixed, as those imposed by law or any ordinance of said Town upon the marshal thereof.

Section 2: The daily hours of service of said deputy marshal shall be from seven o'clock p.m. to seven o'clock a.m.

Section 3: The said deputy marshal shall be required before entering upon the performance of his duties as said deputy marshal, to furnish to the said town, a bond in the penal sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties as said deputy marshal.
