

ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PART OF WALLACE STREET IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: That that part of Wallace Street in the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the East line of Granite Avenue with the South line of Wallace Street; thence running East along the South line of Wallace Street one hundred fifteen (115) feet thence north fifteen (15) feet thence West one hundred fifteen (115) feet to the east line of Granite Avenue thence South along said east line of Granite Avenue fifteen (15) feet to the point of beginning

be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
