

ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NO. 38 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT AND REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CERTAIN ANIMALS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING AND SALE OF THE SAME AND PRESCRIBING THE PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

That section one of Ordinance No. 38 entitled "An ordinance to prevent and regulate the running at large of certain animals within the limits of the town of Granite Falls, Washington, providing for the impounding and sale of the same, and prescribing the punishment for violation thereof" be amended to read as follows:

Section 1: No horse, sheep, goat, swine, ass, mule, jenny, colt, filly, or cattle of any kind shall be allowed to run at large during any hour of the day or night upon any unenclosed lands, public or private, within the limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington or upon any street, avenue, alley or other public place in said Town.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
