

ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SEWER DISTRICT NO. 1 WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF; SPECIFYING AND ADOPTING A PLAN OR SYSTEM OF DRAINAGE THEREFORE; PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWER THEREIN AND SPECIFYING THE TERMINALS AND COURSE OF THE SAME AND PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF THE COST THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby created and established within the limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, a sewer district which shall be designated as Sewer District No. One, and which shall be described located and bounded as follows, to-wit:

Said Sewer District No. One shall include all the area included in Blocks eight (8) and one (1) of the original townsite of Granite Falls, Washington; also the following described tract of land, situated in said town, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the South line of the right of way of the Northern Pacific Railway with the west line of Granite Avenue as the same is laid out and used for street purposes; thence South along said west line of Granite Avenue to the North line of Stanley Street; thence west along said north line of Stanley Street two hundred fifty three (253) feet; thence north at right angles, to an intersection with the south line of the railroad right of way above mentioned; thence east along said south line of said right of way to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That the plan of sewerage devised and submitted by Springer, C.E., and now on file in the office of the Clerk of said town, together with the profiles and specifications therefore, are hereby adopted as, and declared to be the sewerage plan for said Sewer District No. One of Granite Falls, Washington, and all building improvements and construction of sewerage and drainage within said Sewer District No. One shall be made subject to and in conformity with said plan.

Section 3. That whereas it is deemed necessary by said Council for the preservation of the health of the inhabitants of said town; a main or trunk sewer be constructed in said Sewer District No. One, along the following described route, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Granite Avenue with the center line of Stanley Street, thence running West along the center line of Stanley Street to a point due north of the center line of the alley between Cascade Avenue and Granite Avenue; thence south along the center line of said alley to the center line of Union Street; thence west to connect with drain pipe now located under Cascade Avenue on Union Street; that said sewer be constructed according to the plans, profiles and specifications therefor hereinbefore adopted of cement pipe of the diameter shown on said plans with all necessary (T's) for connecting with private premises.

Section 4. That for the purpose of assessing and collecting the cost of construction thereof, there be and is hereby created an improvement district which shall be co-extensive with said Sewer District No. One; and that the cost of said improvement after deducting such sum, not in excess of 25% of the whole cost thereof as the Council may determine by unanimous vote, should be paid from the general expense fund of said Town, shall be taxed and assessed against all the land included in said Sewer District No. One and approximate or contiguous to said sewer, as provided by the laws of the State of Washington.
