ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS ON GRANITE AVENUE, BETWEEN THE SOUTH LINE OF THE RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY AND THE NORTH LINE OF PIONEER STREET, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: All sidewalks hereafter constructed or replaced on Granite Avenue, from the south line of the right of way of the Monte Cristo Branch of the Northern Pacific Railway and the north line of Pioneer Street, shall be constructed of concrete, and shall be ten (10) feet in width.

Section 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
