

ORDINANCE NO. 67

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF GALENA STREET FROM THE WEST LINE OF CASCADE AVENUE TO THE EAST LINE OF PORTAGE AVENUE, IN GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, BY CLEARING AND GRADING THE SAME TO THE ESTABLISHED GRADE, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH A PETITION THEREFOR FILED ON THE 23RD DAY OF DECEMBER, 1911, CREATING A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING THAT PAYMENT FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT BE MADE BY SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS UPON PROPERTY IN SAID DISTRICT PAYABLE BY THE MODE OF "IMMEDIATE PAYMENT."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That Galena Street from the west line of Cascade Avenue to the east line of Portage Avenue be improved by cleaning and grading the same to the established grade, and that such other work be done as may be necessary in connection therewith, according to the plans and specifications therefor prepared by Coast Engineering Co., and on file in the office of the Clerk of said Town.

Section 2: The Town of Granite Falls shall pay out of its general fund, on account of said improvement, an amount equal to 20.8 per cent of the total cost thereof.

Section 3: That the cost and expense of said improvement, including all necessary expnses, except for engineering work heretofore done, and except as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance, shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created in accordance with law. The Town of Granite Falls, Washington, shall not be liable for any of the cost and expense of said improvement, except as herein provided.

Section 4: That there is hereby established a local improvement district to be called "Local Improvement District No. 15," which said district is described as follows:

"All the property between the termini of said improvement, abutting upon, adjacent, vicinal or proximate to such portion of said streets or avenues to a distance back from the marginal line thereof, as provided by law."

Section 5: That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be defrayed by special assessments payable by the mode of "immediate Payment" as defined by law and the ordinances of the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.
