

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS AND DECLARING THE VIOLATION THEREOF A MISDEMEANOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: Any person who shall drive or operate and every owner, lessee, or other person in charge thereof, who shall permit to be operated, any automobile, motorcycle, or motor vehicle, on any public street or highway within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, at a rate of speed faster than one mile in five minutes, or over any crosswalk, crossing or street intersection within the corporate limits of said Town, when any person is upon the same, at a rate of speed greater than one mile in fifteen minutes, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2: Any person who shall drive or operate, and every owner, lessee or other person in charge thereof, who shall permit to be driven or operated, any automobile motorcycle or motor vehicle, on any public street or highway within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, without a muffler, or with a muffler or the cut-out thereto attached or connected, open, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.
