

ORDINANCE NO. 70

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 4 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING MISDEMEANORS AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUNISHMENT THEREOF."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That section 7 of ordinance No. 4 of said Town, entitled "An ordinance defining misdemeanors and providing for the punishment thereof," be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7, No person shall ride or drive any horse or horses, mule or mules, or any beast or beasts of burden over or upon any of the public highways within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls at any inordinate rate of speed, or at any rate of speed greater than six miles per hour; No person shall ride, drive or lead any horse, mule, ox or beast of burden, or ride any bicycle or other vehicle upon any sidewalk or sidewalk strip, whether a sidewalk be constructed thereon or not, within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, provided that bicycles, equipped at all times with bell, and after sunset with lighted lamp, may be ridden at a rate of speed not greater than six miles per hour on the sidewalk or sidewalk strip on the south and east sides of any street within the corporate limits of said Town, except Granite Avenue, and any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
