

ORDINANCE NO. 73

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A GENERAL SEWAGE AND DRAINAGE SYSTEM IN AND FOR THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON; DESCRIBING THE ROUTES ALONG WHICH SAID IMPROVEMENT IS TO BE LOCATED; CREATING A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR PAYMENT THEREOF; AND PROVIDING THAT PAYMENT FOR THE EXPENSE OF SAID IMPROVEMENT BE MADE BY SPECIAL ASSESSMENT UPON THE PROPERTY IN SAID DISTRICT, PAYABLE BY THE MODE OF "PAYMENT BY BONDS", ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF SAID TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, PASSED JUNE 3, 1913 AND PUBLISHED JUNE 6 and JUNE 13, 1913.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That there be constructed a sewage and drainage system in and for the town of Granite Falls, Washington, along the routes herein after described, for the disposal of sewage and drainage in the district herein created; that such sewage and drainage system shall consist of a trunk sewer, with subsewers, branches, laterals, service pipes, connections and side sewers, together with all necessary tunnels, pipes, openings, manholes, catch basins, flushtanks, and all other equipment and appurtenances necessary for the proper and adequate sewerage and draining of the districts to be created to pay the whole or a portion of the cost and expense of said improvement, and of doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, all in accordance with plans therefor prepared by H.D. Springor, C.E. and on file in the office of Clerk of said town.

Section 2: That the routes along which said improvement will be constructed are as follows, to-wit:

Trunk sewer and laterals.

The Trunk sewer beginning at the westerly end of the trunk sewer now constructed on Niman Street, will extend westerly along Union Street to Anderson Avenue, thence in a General Southwesterly direction through Blocks 11 and 12 of the original Town site of the Town of Granite Falls, and through the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 24, Township 30 N.R. 6 E.W.M. to a point of out fall on the Pilchuck River.

As a part of said trunk sewer and in connect therewith there shall be constructed a lateral commencing at the intersection of said trunk sewer with the alley between Portage Avenue and Prospect Avenue, thence north in said alley to a point 35 feet South of Galena Street; also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said trunk sewer with the alley between Prospect Avenue and Anderson Avenue, thence north in said alley to the north line of Stanley Street with a side sewer therefrom commencing at the intersection of said lateral with the center line of Galena Street, thence west on Galena Street to the alley between Portage Avenue and Prospect Avenue, thence north in said alley to a point 35 feet south of Stanley Street; also, a lateral commencing at the intersection of said trunk sewer with the alley between Anderson Avenue and Cascade Avenue, thence north in said alley to the north line of Stanley Street; also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said trunk sewer with the alley between Prospect Avenue and Anderson Avenue, thence South in said alley to a point 35 feet north of Pioneer Street; also, a lateral commencing at the intersection of said trunk sewer with the alley between Anderson Avenue and Cascade Avenue, thence south in said alley to a point 145 feet south of Union Street; Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said trunk sewer with the alley between Cascade Avenue and Granite Avenue, thence South in said alley to a point 145 feet south of Union Street.

Subsewer No. 2 and laterals.

There shall be Constructed in Connection with asid trunk sewer a subsewer and laterals as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the manhole at the east end of Union Street, said manhole being located at the intersection of Union Street with the alley between Cascade Avenue and Granite Avenue thence east on Union Street to the alley between Granite Avenue and Wabash Avenue, thence north in said alley to the center of Stanley Street, thence east on Stanley street, to the center of Alder Avenue, thence north and Alder Avenue eight hundred (800), with laterals therefrom as follows:

A lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer with the center line of Galena Street, thence east on Galena Street to the center of Wabash Avenue, thence north on Wabash Avenue to a point 80 feet south of Stanley Street, also, a lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Stanley Street with the alley between Alder Avenue and Indiana Avenue, thence south in said alley to a point 35 feet North of Galena Street: also a lateral beginning at the intersection of said subsewer on Stanley

Street with the center of North Indiana Avenue, thence north on Indiana Avenue 730 feet;

Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Stanley Street with the center of north Kentucky Avenue, thence north on Kentucky Avenue 350 feet;

Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Union Street with the alley between Granite Avenue and Wabash Avenue, thence east on Union Street to the alley between Indiana Avenue and Alder Avenue with a side sewer therefrom north on said alley to a point 35 feet south of Galena Street;

Also a side sewer therefrom commencing at the intersection of said lateral on Union Street with the alley between Wabash Avenue and Kentucky Avenue, thence north in said alley to the center of Galena Street thence east on Galena Street to the corner of Kentucky Avenue, thence north on Kentucky Avenue to a point 80 feet south of Stanley Street;

Also a side sewer therefrom commencing at the intersection of east Kentucky Avenue and Indiana Avenue, thence north in said alley to the center of Galena Street, thence east on Galena Street to the center of Indiana Avenue, thence north on Indiana Avenue to a point 80 feet south of Stanley Street;

Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Union Street with the alley between Granite Avenue and Wabash Avenue thence south in said alley to a point 200 feet south of Union street.

Subsewer No. 3 and laterals.

There shall also be constructed in connection with said trunk sewer a subsewer and laterals as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the intersection of said trunk sewer with the alley between Portage Avenue and Prospect Avenue, thence South in said alley to the center of Wallace Street, thence east on Wallace Street to the alley between Cascade Avenue and Anderson Avenue, thence south in said alley to the center of Grand Street; thence east on Grand Street to the center of Kentucky Avenue, thence north on Kentucky Avenue to the center of Pioneer Street, thence east on Pioneer Street to a point 60 feet east of the alley between Alder Avenue and Indiana Avenue, with laterals therefrom as follows:

A lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Pioneer Street with the alley between Indiana

Avenue and Alder Avenue, thence north in said alley to a point 35 feet south of Union Street;

Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Pioneer Street with the alley between Kentucky Avenue and Indiana Avenue, thence north in said alley to a point 35 feet south of Union Street;

Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Grand Street with the center of Wabash Avenue, thence north on Wabash Avenue to the center of Pioneer Street; thence east on Pioneer Street to the alley between Wabash Avenue and Kentucky Avenue, thence north in said alley to a point 35 feet south of Union Street;

Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Grand Street with the center of Granite Avenue to a point 35 feet south of Wallace Street and from the same subsewer intersection south on Granite Avenue to a point 160 feet south of Grand Street;

Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Grand Street with the alley between Granite Avenue and Cascade Avenue, thence north on said alley to a point 145 feet north of Pioneer Street;

Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said sewer on Wallace Street with the alley between Cascade Avenue and Anderson Avenue, thence north in said alley to a point 145 feet north of Pioneer Street;

Also a lateral commencing at the intersection of said subsewer on Wallace Street with the alley between Prospect Avenue and Anderson Avenue, thence North in said alley to a point 35 feet south of Pioneer Street.

Subsewer No. 4

There shall also be constructed in connection with said trunk sewer a subsewer as follows:

Commencing at the end of the sewer heretofore constructed at the intersection of Stanley Street and Granite Avenue, thence north on Granite Avenue 200 feet.

Section 3: That the cost and expense of said improvement including all necessary and incidental expenses shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created in accordance with law.

The town of Granite Falls, shall not be liable for any portion of the cost and expense of said improvement, except as herein provided.

Section 4: That there is hereby established a local improvement district to be called Local Improvement District No. 16 which, said district shall be outlined in accordance with topographical conditions and shall include, as near as may be, all the territory which can be sewer, served or drained through such trunk, sewer, subsewer, laterals and connected therewith, and is described as follows, to-wit:

All property except public street and alleys included in the tract of land bounded as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of lot 3, Sec. 18, Tp. 30 N R 7 E.W.M., thence south on the west line of said lot 3, same being the corporate limits of said town 660 feet more or less to a point where said corporate limits turn to west;

Thence west along said corporate limits 1320 feet more or less to intersection with the west line of the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 13 Tp. 30 N.R. 6 E.W.M., thence south along said west line and along the west line of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 30 N.R. 6 E.W.M., and along the west of the N.E. 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 24 Tp. 30 N.R. 6 E.W.M. same being the corporate limits of said Town to a point 135 feet south of the south line of Wallace Street as same is laid out and dedicated in said town; thence east parallel to the south line of Wallace Street to a point 253 feet west of the West line of Cascade Avenue, as same is laid out and dedicated in said town; thence south parallel to the west line of Cascade Avenue, to a point 133 feet west of these corner of lot 6 Block 18 of the original Townsite of Granite Falls, thence east to a point 225 feet west of the east corner of lot 6, Blk. 17 of the O.T. of Granite Falls; thence south to a point 135 feet south of the south line of Grand Street; as the same is laid out in said town; thence east to a point 120 feet west of the west line of Granite Avenue, as same is laid out; thence south to a point 265 feet south of the south line of Grand Street; thence east to a point 743 feet east of the east line of Granite Avenue; thence north to a point 663 feet south of the south line of Pioneer;

Thence east to an intersection with the east line of the north west 1/4 of the NE 1/4, Sec. 19 Tp 30 N.R. 7 E.W.M., said line being the corporate limits of said town;

Thence north along said east line and along the east line of lot 4 Sec. 18 Tp. 30 N.R. 7 E.W.M. said line being corporate limits, to the N.E. corner of said lot 4 thence east along corporate limits 264 feet; thence north along the corporate limits to an intersection with the north line of the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 18 Tp. 30 N.R. 7 E.W.M., thence west along corporate limits to the point of beginning.

Section 5: Bonds bearing interest at the rate of 7 percent per annum payable on or before ten years from the date of issuance, shall be issued in payment of the cost and expense of this improvement, which bonds shall be redeemed by the collection of special assessments to be levied and assessed upon the property within said district, payable in ten equal annual installments with interest at the rate of 7 percent per annum, under the mode "payment by bonds", as defined by law and ordinance of the Town of Granite Falls. These bonds shall be delivered to the contractor in redemption of warrants on the local improvement district fund issued on estimates of the town engineer, or the town of Granite Falls may at its election sell said bonds and make redemptions in cash.

Section 6: That the plans and specifications prepared by S. D. Springer, C.E. for said improvement and now on file in the office of the Town Clerk be and the same are hereby adopted and specified as the plans and specifications for said improvements.

Section 7: The Town of Granite Falls shall pay assessment on property owned by said Town other than streets and alleys and in addition shall pay out of its general fund the sum of one thousand dollars of the expense of said trunk sewer.

Section 8: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
