

ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF A TOWN CLERK, AND FOR FILLING VACANCIES IN SAID OFFICE, PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF SAID TOWN CLERK AND FIXING HIS COMPENSATION."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1 be amended to read as follows:

The Town Clerk shall receive a monthly salary of seventeen dollars and fifty cents for his services and such other and further compensation as the Council may from time to time provide for the performance of any unusual or extra services performed by him.

Section 2: This ordinance shall go in effect October 1, 1913.
