

ORDINANCE NO. 75

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 22 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES OF VOTING PRECINCTS IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, PROVIDING A PLACE WHERE ELECTIONS SHALL BE HELD; FOR THE APPOINTING OF A BOARD OF ELECTION AND REGULATING THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS FOR TOWN OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That Sec. 1 of Ordinance No. 22 be amended to read as follows:

There shall be two voting precincts in the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, to-wit:

All that part of said Town lying to the west of the center of Granite Avenue shall be known as Precinct No. 1; all that part of said Town lying east of the center line of Granite Avenue shall be known as Precinct No. 2.

Section 2: That Sec. 2 of Ordinance No. 22 be amended as follows: The voting places in each precinct shall be at such buildings as the town Council may from time to time designate.

Section 3: That whenever an election is to be held the Town Council shall appoint for each precinct one inspector, two judges and two clerks, whose compensation shall be 37 1/2 cents per hour.
