

ORDINANCE NO. 79

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF GALENA STREET FROM THE EAST LINE OF KENTUCKY AVENUE TO THE WEST LINE OF INDIANA AVENUE, BY CLEARING AND GRADING THE SAME FOR THE FULL WIDTH THEREOF TO THE ESTABLISHED GRADE, CREATING A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT THEREOF, AND PROVIDING THAT PAYMENT FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE MADE BY SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS UPON PROPERTY IN SAID DISTRICT PAYABLE BY THE MODE OF "IMMEDIATE PAYMENT", ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH A PETITION THEREFOR FILED JUNE 3, 1913.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That Galena Street, from the east line of Kentucky Avenue to the west line of Indiana Avenue, be improved for the full width thereof by clearing and grading the same to the established grade, and that such other work may be done as may be necessary in connection therewith, according to the plans, profiles and specifications therefor prepared and on file in the office of the Clerk of said Town.

Section 2: That the cost and expense of said improvement, including all necessary and incidental expenses, shall be borne by and be assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created in accordance with law. The Town of Granite Falls shall not be liable in any manner for any portion of the cost and expense of said improvement, except for the proportion for alley intersection.

Section 3: That there is hereby established a local improvement district, to be called "Local Improvement District No. 17" which said district is described as follows:

All the property between the termini of said improvement, abutting upon, adjacent, vicinal or proximate to such portion of said street to a distance back from the marginal line thereof as provided by law.

Section 4: The cost and expense of said improvement shall be defrayed by special assessment payable by the mode

of "Immediate Payment" as defined by law and ordinance of the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.
