

ORDINANCE NO. 81

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS FOR A TERM LESS THAN ONE YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: All licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors issued in the Town of Granite Falls, after the 31st day of December, 1914, shall be issued for a term ending at midnight on December 31, 1915.

Section 2: The license fee for such short term licenses shall be a pro-rata proportion (based upon the time such license has to run), of the license fee for a license of the same classification prescribed by Section 3 of Ordinance 78, of said Town of Granite Falls.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
