

ORDINANCE NO. 85

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 65 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF WATER SUPERINTENDENT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND SALARY THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR FIXING, REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE USES AND PRICE OF THE WATER SUPPLIED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That Section 32 of Ordinance No. 65 be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 32: The monthly rates for water shall be as follows:

Residence, including bath and toilet, inside the corporate limits for the months from May to September, both inclusive, \$1.20; outside the corporate limits \$1.50; inside the corporate limits for the months from October to April, both inclusive, \$1.00; outside the corporate limits \$1.25; provided that for the month of December in each year no charge shall be made to any residence which has used water for all the preceding months of said year.

Residence and business combined pay business rate only.

Fire hydrants four dollars per hydrant per year.

Constant flow urinal, closet or sprinkler \$1.00 in addition to rate otherwise taken by premises.

Meter Rates

Minimum per month	\$1.50
First 1500 cubic feet	\$.20 per 100 ft.
1500 feet to 3000 feet	\$.14 per 100 ft.
3000 feet to 6000 feet	\$.08 per 100 ft.
6000 feet to 20,000 feet	\$.05 per 100 ft.

Section 2: At the time of making application for the use of water as provided in Section 5 of this ordinance the applicant shall deposit with the Town Treasurer an amount equal to the cost of tapping the main, furnishing corporation cock, stop and waste, pipe and service box, trenching and back filling necessary to furnish water at the curb line; computation to be based on distance from middle of street to curb line, under any contract for such service to which the Town may at the time be a party, which deposit shall be entered to the credit of the property to be served. Thereafter a deduction of fifty cents shall be made from each months water rental chargeable to said property until the total of such monthly deductions equals the amount of such deposit.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the 10th day of May, 1916.
