

RDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 84 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUORS, PROHIBITING THE MANUFACTURE, KEEPING, SALE AND DISPOSITION THEREOF EXCEPT IN CERTAIN CASES; THE SOLICITING AND TAKING OF ORDERS THEREFOR AND ADVERTISING THEREOF; DECLARING CERTAIN PLACES TO BE NUISANCES AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR ABATEMENT; REGULATING THE KEEPING, SALE AND DISPOSITION OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS BY PHARMACISTS AND DRUGGISTS; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEARCH FOR AND SEIZURE AND DESTRUCTION THEREOF, AND OF PROPERTY USED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; PRESCRIBING THE FORMS OF PROCEDURE AND RULES OF EVIDENCE IN CASES AND PROCEEDINGS HEREUNDER; AND FIXING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF." BY ADDING THERETO PROVISIONS FOR MAKING MORE CERTAIN THE USES FOR WHICH PURCHASES OF ALCOHOL ARE MADE, AND PROHIBITING THE FILLING OF PRESCRIPTIONS FOR INTOXICATING LIQUOR IN PARTS AT DIFFERENT TIMES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

That Ordinance No. 84 of said Town be amended by adding thereto the following, to-wit:

Section 19: It shall be unlawful for any druggist or pharmacist to sell alcohol for chemical or mechanical purposes except upon written permit, to be issued to the purchaser by the Town Clerk or Marshal, as the Town Council may from time to time by resolution direct, on forms to be provided by the said Town, which forms shall set forth the exact use for which said alcohol is to be used, which permits when filled shall be canceled and filed in the manner in this ordinance provided for the cancellation and filing of physician's prescriptions, and shall not thereafter be filed again.

Section 20: Any prescription for intoxicating liquor shall be filled as an entirety at one time, and it shall be unlawful to fill such prescription in parts at different times, or to deliver to the purchaser parts of such prescriptions at different times.

Section 21: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
