

ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE WIDTH AND MATERIAL OF SIDEWALKS TO BE HEREAFTER CONSTRUCTED ON ANY OF THE STREETS AND AVENUES IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That all sidewalks hereafter constructed on any of the public streets or avenues within the corporate limits of said town shall be constructed of concrete in manner as provided by Ordinance No. 72 of said Town.

Section 2: That all sidewalks hereafter constructed on Granite Avenue between the south line of the Northern Pacific Railway Company's right-of-way and the north line of Pioneer Street shall be ten (10) feet in width; that all sidewalks hereafter constructed on Stanley Street between the east line of Cascade Avenue and the west line of Wabash Avenue, shall be six (6) feet in width; and that all sidewalks hereafter constructed on any other street or avenue in said Town shall be four (4) feet in width.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
