

ORDINANCE NO. 90

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES
WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS AND DECLARING THE VIOLATION
THEREOF A MISDEMEANOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite
Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That any person desiring of parking or
leaving upon the streets when not in motion, any automobile
motorcycle, motortruck or motor vehicle, upon any public
street within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite
Falls, Washington, shall conform to the following regulations.

Section 2: That any such automobile, motorcycle, motor-
truck or motor vehicle shall be parked in such a manner that
one of the front wheels of such vehicle shall be touching
the curb of the street and one of the rear wheels of the
vehicle shall be within 48 inches of said curb.

Section 3: That no automobile, motorcycle, motor-
truck or motor vehicle shall be parked within the square
made by the intersection of two streets, or within twenty
feet thereof.

Section 4: That any person violating any of the
provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be
punished by a fine not exceeding twenty-five (\$25.00)
dollars.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage and publication according
to law.
