

ORDINANCE NO. 95

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 ORDINANCE NO. 86 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN STREETS AND AVENUES IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS, CURBS, STREET AND ALLEY CROSSINGS THEREON; CREATING A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE EXPENSE THEREOF; AND PROVIDING THAT PAYMENT FOR THE EXPENSE OF SAID IMPROVEMENT BE MADE BY SPECIAL ASSESSMENT UPON THE PROPERTY IN SAID DISTRICT PAYABLE BY THE MODE OF "PAYMENT BY BONDS," ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE SAID TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASH. PASSED MAY 9th 1916 AND PUBLISHED MAY 12, 1916 AND MAY 19, 1916.

THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DOES ORDAIN:

~~Section 1: That Sec. 3 of Ord. No. 86 of said Town of Granite Falls, Wash., be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of the following clause:~~

That the special fund is hereby created to be called "Local Improvement District Fund No. 18" which shall consist in the aggregate of the several amounts assessed, levied and collected on the several lots and parcels of land in said Local Improvement District and the proceeds of the sale of the bonds of the district for the purpose of defraying the cost and expense of such improvement. Out of said fund shall be paid the bonds, interest thereon and the entire cost of said improvement.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
