ORDINANCE No. 282

An Ordinance amending the 1979 Tax Budget in the amount of 12,708 - Current Expense Fund and 6,546 in Arterial St. Fund and transferring 4700 from Arterial Street to Street.

WHEREAS, sufficient revenue has been collected from property and sales taxes and expenditures have occurred that were not anticipated when the 1979 budget was adopted, the 1979 budget is amended as follows:

Section 1. In the Current Expense Fund: 932 Revenue Sharing carried forward from planned use in 1978, 600 Police Dept, 332- Office supplies, 100-expense of Planning Committee, 60-marshal lunches at Chiefs meetings, 3500-Police Dept. expense, 4150 salary assistant utilities superintendant and 3966 for 1978-79 audit.


Section 2. Transfer 4700 designated matching funds from Arterial Street to Street Fund and

Section 3. Amending Street Fund by 6546 to pay 1846 to Snohomish County for work done but not billed in 1978 and adding 4700 transfer from Arterial Street Fund.
