ORDINANCE NO. 285

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE AND
REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF
ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS:

Section 1. Adoption By Reference: There is hereby adopted by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion, that certain code known as the Uniform Fire Code developed by the International Conference of Building Officials and the Western Fire Chiefs Association, being particularly the 1976 edition thereof, and the whole thereof, of which Code not less than three (3) copies have been and now are filed with the City Clerk of the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 2. Definitions:

2.1 Whenever the word "code" is used in the Uniform Fire Code, it shall mean the Uniform Fire Code, 1976 edition.

2.2 Whenever the word "municipality" is used in the Uniform Fire Code, it shall mean the Town of Granite Falls.

2.3 Whenever the term "corporation counsel" is used in the Uniform Fire Code, it shall mean the town attorney for the Town of Granite Falls.

2.4 Whenever the words "Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention" are used in the Uniform Fire Code, they shall be held to mean the County Fire Marshal.

2.5 Whenever the terms "Chief", "Chief of the Fire Department", or "Fire Chief" are used in the Uniform Fire Code, they shall mean the Fire Chief of Snohomish County Fire District No. 17.

2.6 Whenever the term "fire department" is used in the Uniform Fire Code, it shall mean Snohomish County Fire District No. 17.

Section 3. Appendices Adopted: All appendices to the Uniform Fire Code, 1976 edition, are hereby adopted, incorporated by reference, and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this section, except Appendix H.

Section 4. Incorporation of Mobile Home Ordinance: The Town of Granite Falls Ordinance No. 225, applying to mobile homes and mobile home trailer courts, is hereby adopted, incorporated by reference, and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this section.

Section 5. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances: All former Ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance or of the Code hereby adopted are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Severability: If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances, is not affected.

Section 7. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the 12 th day of March, 1980.
