

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS
SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 302

An Ordinance providing for the annexation to the Town of Granite Falls of certain property in Section 13, Township 30 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Site.

The Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, does ordain:

Section 1. Whereas, the Town of Granite Falls did purchase the property described below for use as a site for the proposed Wastewater Treatment Plant, and to annex the property to the Town of Granite Falls. A meeting was duly set before the Town Council for the 22nd day of October, 1980; and, at said meeting, the Town Council agreed to file an application for annexation with the Snohomish County, Boundary Review Board, in accordance with the provisions of RCW, Chapter 36.93. A hearing having been regularly held before said Boundary Review Board, at 8:00 P.M., on the 9th day of December, 1980; following which hearing said Boundary Review Board approved the proposal for such annexation, in accordance with the provisions of RCW 36.93.150.

Section 2. The following described property be, and the same hereby is annexed to the Town of Granite Falls, Snohomish County, Washington:

Beginning at the northeast corner of the southeast 1/4 of the southeast 1/4 of Section 13, Township 30 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; thence west 1,320 feet; thence south 1,650 feet to the southwesterly corner of the original Townsite of Granite Falls, as recorded in the original Town Site of Granite Falls, Dedication, on August 4, 1891, said point being the true point of beginning; thence north 330 feet, along the westerly right-of-way line of Portage Avenue; thence west 430 feet; thence south 330 feet; thence east 430 feet to the true point of beginning.

Said property being subject to: an easement in favor of the Grantors, their heirs or assigns, over and upon the south 30 feet for 430 feet from the southeast corner thereof for ingress, egress and utilities for the benefit of the Grantors, their heirs and assigns.

Section 3. The effective date of such annexation shall be the date of this Ordinance. The property annexed shall not assume any bonded indebtedness to the Town of Granite Falls.

Passed at a regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, held on the 11 day of March, 1981, and
