

ORDINANCE NO. 308

AN ORDINANCE DESCRIBING THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS AND PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION FOR THE OFFICE OF CLERK OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The mayor shall appoint a clerk who shall hold office during the pleasure of the mayor, as provided by the laws of the state of Washington.

Section 2. The clerk, before entering upon the duties of the office, shall take and file an oath of office and execute a bond approved by the council in such sum as the council by ordinance may determine, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties including in the same bond the duties of all offices of which the clerk is made ex officio incumbent. The bonds of the clerk shall be filed with the mayor.

Section 3. The town clerk shall keep all books and records and perform such duties as are required by the provisions of the laws of the state of Washington. In addition, the clerk shall perform all other duties required by ordinance or resolution passed by the town council prior to or during the term of office.

Section 4. The clerk shall be paid such compensation as shall be provided by ordinance. The clerk may be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the discharge of official duties upon presentation of a claim therefor and its allowance and approval by resolution of the council.

Section 14. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 15. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

Introduced by the Town Council and APPROVED by the Mayor this 12 th day of August, 1981.

This Ordinance shall become effective August 12 th, 1981.


