

ORDINANCE NO. 311

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A LIBRARY BOARD OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, AND PROVIDING FOR MEETINGS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created and established a Library Board of the city of Granite Falls, composed of five trustees, as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. The Library Board is hereby declared to be an administrative board of the city of Granite Falls, whose duties shall include the general supervision of the library facilities of the city of Granite Falls and performing such other duties as the mayor may direct. The Library Board shall serve without compensation.

Section 3. The mayor shall appoint, with the consent of the Council, five trustees of the Library Board who shall each serve for a term of five years provided however, only one trustee position term shall expire in any one calendar year. No trustee shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms. Nothing herein contained shall prohibit the mayor from removing any member from office, should it, in the mayor's discretion, be deemed advisable.

Section 4. The Library Board shall hold regular meetings, at such times and places as it deems advisable, but shall hold not less than one regular meeting in each calendar month.

Section 5. The Library Board shall elect a chair from its membership who shall serve for one year and a secretary who shall serve for a like period, and who shall keep minutes and records of all meetings.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
