

ORDINANCE NO. 312

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND IMPOSING A SALES AND USE TAX OF <sup>.425</sup> OF ONE PERCENT, AND PROVIDING FOR A CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. A sales and use tax in the amount of <sup>.425</sup> of one percent of the selling price (in the case of the sales tax) or value of the article used (in the case of use tax) will be and the same hereby is fixed and imposed upon all taxable events, as defined in RCW 82.14.020, occurring within the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 2. The administration and collection of the tax imposed by this ordinance shall be in accordance with the provisions of RCW 82.14.050.

Section 3. The Mayor and Clerk may enter a contract with the Department of Revenue for administration of the tax.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

Introduced by the Town Council and APPROVED by the Mayor this 12 th day of August, 1981.

This Ordinance shall become effective August 12 th, 1981.


