

ORDINANCE NO. 319

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL ORDINANCES TO ESTABLISH THE FINE FOR VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE 290 CONCERNING DOGS AND ANIMALS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Any violation of Ordinance 290 shall be punished by a fine as established by the town council from time to time by special ordinance.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

Introduced by the Town Council and APPROVED by the Mayor this 12 th day of August, 1981.

This Ordinance shall become effective August 12 th, 1981.
