SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 322

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 300, THE 1981 TAX BUDGET AS FOLLOWS TO INCLUDE UNFORSEEN EXPENDITURES IN THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1: The Town of Granite Falls hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the Town to decrease the total appropriation for the Revenue Sharing Account.

Section 2: Whereas the Current Expense Fund is amended in the following categories by the amounts indicated..

510.30 Municipal Revolving Fund, \$2400.00

521.11 Salaries plus Social Security and Industrial Insurance, \$1346.00.

521.30 Other services and charges, \$4000.00.

Section 3: Therefore be it ordained by the Town Council of Granite Falls, Washington that \$7746.00 be expended in the Current Expense fund to pay for unforeseen expenses in the Current Expense fund.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 9th day of September 1981.
