SPECIAL ORDINANCE No. 323

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 300, THE 1981 TAX BUDGET AS FOLLOWS
TO INCLUDE CAPITAL EXPENDITURES IN THE SEWER FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE
FALLS, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1: Whereas the Sewer fund is amended in the
following categories by the amounts indicated to include Capital
Expenditures in the Sewer fund.

534.00 Utilities and Enterprises -Sewer
40 Sewer
60 Capital Outlay
62 Buildings- Total Sheldrup Construction \$1,882,985.00
63 Collection System - Total King Construction \$888,944.00

Section 2 : Therefore be it ordained by the Town Council
of Granite Falls, Washington that \$2,771,929.00 be expended in the
Sewer fund to pay for Capital Outlay for Sewer Construction.
