

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON
SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 324

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON THE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON FOR THE YEAR 1982 IN THE SUM OF \$35,336.00 REGULAR LEVY AND \$6500.00 SPECIAL LEVY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

Section 1: There is hereby levied upon the real and personal property within the Town of Granite Falls with respect to the general levy for the year 1981, the sum of \$35,336.00.

Section 2: There is hereby levied upon the real and personal taxable property within the Town of Granite Falls for the year 1982, pursuant to the Special Levy adopted by the election held on the 3rd day of November 1981, the sum of \$6500.00.

Section 3: The proceeds of the foregoing regular and special levies are to be placed as follows: \$28,949.00 in the General Operating Fund, \$6387.00 in the Street Fund and \$6500.00 in the Library Fund.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after it's passage, approval and posting according to law.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 23 rd day of September 1981.
