

ORDINANCE NO. 328

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2.28

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance 2.28.050 that reads:

2.28.050 Powers--Duties. The Board thus constituted shall have all the powers and perform all the duties as provided by the laws of the state of Washington relating to Board of Park Commissioners of municipalities of the fourth class (towns). The Board shall have the power to conduct any form of cultural or recreational activity that will employ the leisure time of the people in a constructive and wholesome manner, and shall control and have supervision of all parks belonging to said town, and may plan, promote, manage and acquire, construct, develop, maintain and operate either within or without the town limits, parks, squares, parkways and boulevards, play and recreational grounds and other municipally owned recreation facilities, including community buildings and improve and ornament the same; enter into contracting writing, acting independently or in conjunction with the United States, the state of Washington, any county, city or town, park district, school district or any such public organizations for the purpose of conducting a recreation program or exercising any other power granted by this ordinance; exercise censorship over any statuary, monuments or works of art presented to the town. †The Board may also solicit or receive on behalf of the Town Council any gifts or bequests of money or other personal property or any donation to be applied, principal or income, for either temporary or permanent use for playgrounds, parks or other recreational purposes. Powers of said Board shall include the authority to grant concessions and privileges herein under such restrictions and for such compensation as it shall prescribe, the revenue from which shall be used for park purposes. Provided that no concession or privilege shall ever be granted for the sale of any intoxicating liquors, beer, or wine, in any public park, and that no concession or privilege shall be granted for a period of more than three years unless approved by ordinance. The Board shall have no power to acquire land or property without the approval of the Town Council, and any property shall be in the name of the town. (Ord. 241 §5, 1969).
