ORDINANCE NO. ~~328~~ 330

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR GARBAGE  
COLLECTION SERVICE WITHIN AND ABOUT THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS,  
AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES  
IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS;

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SECTION 1: AMENDMENTS: Ordinances Nos. 265, 289, and 315  
are hereby amended as the same refer to rates charged for garbage collection  
service.

SECTION 2: GARBAGE CANS:

- 2.1 No customer served by garbage cans shall use a garbage can in excess of 32 gallons in capacity and weighing in excess of 65 pounds.
- 2.2. All garbage cans shall have a tight-fitting lid and shall be maintained in good and clean condition.
- 2.3 Each customer shall provide the cans necessary to serve the needs of the location and shall be solely responsible for the maintenance and condition of such cans.

SECTION 3: DUMPSTERS: The Town may elect to serve any customer other than a single-family residence with a dumpster; and

- 3.1 Any customer served by a dumpster shall provide a location adequate for the placing of the dumpster, which location and access thereto shall be approved by the Town Engineer or his designee.
- 3.2 The customer shall maintain clear access to the dumpster.
- 3.3 The customer shall maintain the dumpster in good condition and shall keep the area around it in a clean and sanitary condition,
- 3.4 The monthly rental will be increased 10 % when the lease is renewed.

SECTION 4: MONTHLY CHARGES: The following monthly charges shall be charged for garbage-collection services:

4.1 Single-Family Dwelling:

- 4.1.1. Two or less cans - \$ 6.75 per month

- 4.1.2 For each additional can: \$ 1.75 per can per pickup.
- 4.2 Apartments, Duplex, Triplex, Fourplex, or other Multi-Unit Dwelling:  
See Section 4.4 below
- 4.3 Mobile Homes and Trailers:
- 4.3.1 Two or less cans - \$ 6.75 per month
- 4.4.2 For each additional can: \$ 1.75 per can per pickup
- 4.4 Businesses and Commercial Establishments:
- 4.4.1 Two or less cans - \$ 6.75 per month
- 4.4.2. For each additional can: \$ 1.75 per can per pick-up.
- 4.4.3 The Town may elect to serve any customer by placing a dumpster on the customer's premises and if so elected, the charges shall be:
- 4.4.3.1 Dumpster rental: \$12.00 per month
- 4.4.3.2 For each emptying of a dumpster: \$ 5.25
- 4.5 GAS STATIONS:
- 4.5.1 Two or less cans - \$ 6.75 per month
- 4.5.2 For each additional can: \$ 1.75 per can per pick-up.
- 4.5.3 The Town may elect to serve any customer by placing a dumpster on the customer's premises and if so elected, the charges shall be:
- 4.5.3.1 Dumpster rental: \$12.00 per month
- 4.5.3.2 For each emptying of a dumpster: \$ 5.25
- 4.6 Churches and Other Non-Profit Public Meeting Places:
- 4.6.1 Two or less cans - \$ 6.75 per month
- 4.6.2 For each additional can - \$ 1.75 per can per pick-up
- 4.6.3 The Town may elect to serve any customer by placing a dumpster on the customer's premises and if so elected, the charges shall be:
- 4.6.3.1 Dumpster rentals: \$12.00 per month
- 4.6.3.2 For each emptying of a dumpster: \$ 5.25

4.7 Senior Citizen Discount:

4.7.1 Two cans or less: \$4.00

4.7.2 Each additional can: \$ 1.00 per pick-up

SECTION 5: DELINQUENCY: If a garbage-collection bill is two months delinquent, at the end of the two months a fine of \$ 10.00 will be due after the tenth of each month.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the 1st day of JUNE 1982.

SECTION 7: SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance or it's application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 1st day of April, 1982.

SEWER SYSTEM

1) Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation - Schedule II (G&O #81515)

I. Replace Existing Sanitary Sewer Lines:

1. Replace 1,120' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Grand Street from Kentucky Avenue to Cascade Avenue.
2. Replace 640' ± of 8" and 450' ± of 12" sanitary sewer pipe on Wallace Street from Cascade Avenue to Portage Avenue.
3. Replace 645' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Pioneer Street from Alder Avenue to Kentucky Avenue.
4. Replace 1,250' ± of 8" and 825' ± of 12" sanitary sewer pipe on Union Street from Alder Avenue to Prospect Avenue.
5. Replace 330' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Galena Street from Anderson Avenue to Portage Avenue.
6. Replace 1,600' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Stanley Street from Alder Avenue to Portage Avenue.
7. Replace 1,175' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Alder Avenue North of Stanley Street.
8. Replace 165' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Indiana Avenue North of Stanley Street.
9. Replace 680' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Kentucky Avenue from Grand Street to Pioneer Street and 510' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Kentucky Avenue North of Stanley Street.
10. Replace 585' ± of sanitary sewer pipe on Wabash Avenue from Grand Street to Pioneer Street.
11. Replace 410' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Granite Avenue from Grand Street to Wallace Street and 220' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Granite Avenue North of Stanley Street.
12. Replace 350' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe on Cascade Avenue from Grand Street to Wallace Street.
13. Replace 770' ± of 12" sanitary sewer pipe on Prospect Avenue from Wallace Street to Union Street.
14. Replace 1,010' ± of 8" sanitary sewer pipe in the alley between Alder Avenue and Indiana Avenue from Pioneer Street to Stanley Street.

15. Replace 750'  $\pm$  of 8" sanitary sewer pipe in the alley between Indiana Avenue & Kentucky Avenue from Pioneer Street to Galena Street.
16. Replace 1,185'  $\pm$  of 8" sanitary sewer pipe in the alley between Kentucky Avenue & Wabash Avenue from Pioneer Street to Stanley Street.
17. Replace 1,120'  $\pm$  of 8" sanitary sewer pipe in the alley between Wabash Avenue & Granite Avenue from Pioneer Street to Stanley Street.
18. Replace 1,815'  $\pm$  of 8" sanitary sewer pipe in the alley between Granite Avenue & Cascade Avenue from Grand Street to Stanley Street.
19. Replace 1,520'  $\pm$  of 8" sanitary sewer pipe in the alley between Cascade Avenue & Anderson Avenue from Grand Street to Stanley Street.
20. Replace 1,100'  $\pm$  of 8" sanitary sewer pipe in the alley between Anderson Avenue & Prospect Avenue from Wallace Street to Stanley Street.
21. Replace 335'  $\pm$  of 8" sanitary sewer pipe in the alley between Prospect Avenue & Portage Avenue from Galena Street to Stanley Street.

II. Repair Existing Sanitary Sewer Lines:

1. Excavate and repair two shears on Granite Avenue between Northeast 101st Street and Northeast 102nd Street.
2. Excavate and repair two shears on 197th Avenue Northeast between Northeast 101st Street and Northeast 102nd Street.

III. Pressure Grout and/or Repair: Four existing sanitary manholes.

IV. Construct Storm Drainage Lines:

1. Construct 480'  $\pm$  of 24" through 15" storm sewer pipe and appurtenances to include catch basin connections on Wallace Street from Cascade Avenue to Portage Avenue.
2. Construct 375'  $\pm$  of 15" storm sewer pipe and appurtenances to include catch basin connections on Cascade Avenue from Grand Street to Wallace Street.
3. Construct 835'  $\pm$  of 12" storm sewer pipe and appurtenances to include catch basin connections on Stanley Street from Wabash Avenue to Anderson Avenue.

4. Construct 895' + of 12" storm sewer pipe and appurtenances to include catch basin connections on Anderson Avenue from Union Street to Stanley Street.

2) Wastewater Treatment Facility - Schedule I (G&O #81515).

Construct a secondary wastewater treatment facility on undeveloped land presently owned by the Town of Granite Falls, West of the intersection of Wallace Street and Portage Avenue. The facility shall utilize a modified form of the activated sludge process to provide secondary treatment to the wastewater prior to discharge to the Pilchuck River. The major components of the facility will consist of a headworks structure, oxidation ditch, final clarifiers, a chlorine contact tank, sludge drying facilities, an aerobic holding tank, a plant drain and lift station, and a new 12" outfall line to the Pilchuck River. A new laboratory and operations building housing the plant auxiliary power unit and a complete electrical distribution system, will be provided. The entire site will be fenced and landscaped.

All sewer system improvements shall be connected one to the other and to the existing system and shall be provided with all appurtenances as necessary for a serviceable system, and all to be constructed of long-life materials. Modifications of the foregoing described system improvements may be accomplished by the Town, when in the Town's judgment the modifications appear to be advisable and advantageous to the Town, and do not substantially alter the purposes herein set forth.
