SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 339

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 337, THE 1983 TAX BUDGET, AS FOLLOWS TO INCLUDE A SALARY INCREASE, PLUS BENEFITS, IN THE SEWER FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1: The current Sewer Fund of the 1983 Tax Budget shall be amended in the amount of \$1000.00 plus \$ 200.00 for benefits, to allow for a salary increase of \$100.00 per month for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting; according to law.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 9th day of March, 1983.
