

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS

ORDINANCE NO. 341

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND  
REGULATION OF CERTAIN AMUSEMENT DEVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls,  
Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Any person, firm or corporation who shall have or possess, or shall place or permit to be placed or kept in any building or part thereof, owned, leased or occupied by said person, any slot machine, pull tab machine, pinball machine, juke box, video machine, or machines of skill, chance or entertainment, and table for hire, or other article, device or apparatus operated for the losing or winning of money, merchandise, or game of skill or entertainment, such machines using a coin to operate or other payment to the possessor, shall pay into the town trasury such license fee as stated within this ordinance.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation who shall have or possess said machine as described above shall pay into the town treasury such license fee in the amount of \$3.00 per machine per month.

Section 3. It shall be the responsibility of any person, firm or corporation who shall have or possess such machine as described above to notify the Town treasurer within 15 days if a machine is installed or removed from said premises.

Section 4. Failure to pay said license fee within 15 days of date billing shall result in immediate order to remove such machine.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

This Ordinance shall become effective on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1983.
