ORDINANCE NO. 344

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE 1983 SEWER FUND FOR UNFORESEEN EXPENSES IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY.

WHEREAS the construction of the Wastewater Treatment Plant was not completed in 1982 as planned and expenses were paid to the contractor and engineer in the amount of \$11721.11 in 1983; and

WHEREAS the 1982 Sewer Fund, Contractual Construction, Account No. 534.40.63, had a balance remaining of at least \$11721.11;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. The current Sewer Fund of the 1983 Tax Budget, Account No. 534.40.63, Contractual Construction, shall be increased in the amount of \$11721.11 from the 1982 Sewer Fund, Account No. 534.40.63, Contractual Construction.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting, according to law.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 27 day of July, 1983.
