ORDINANCE NO. 350

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 337, THE 1983 TAX BUDGET, TO INCLUDE UNFORSEEN EXPENDITURES IN THE GARBAGE FUND.

WHEREAS the cost of operating the garbage department was more than anticipated at the adoption of the 1983 Budget; and

WHEREAS the garbage fund currently has a fund balance of at least \$2100.00;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. The current Garbage Fund of the 1983 Tax Budget, shall be amended in the amount of \$2100.00. This amount shall be applied as follows: \$1370.00 to 534.50.11 (Salaries & Wages) and \$730.00 to 534.50.20 (Supplies).

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting, according to law.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 28 day of December, 1983.
